 Aims of development can conflict with stories that honor agency

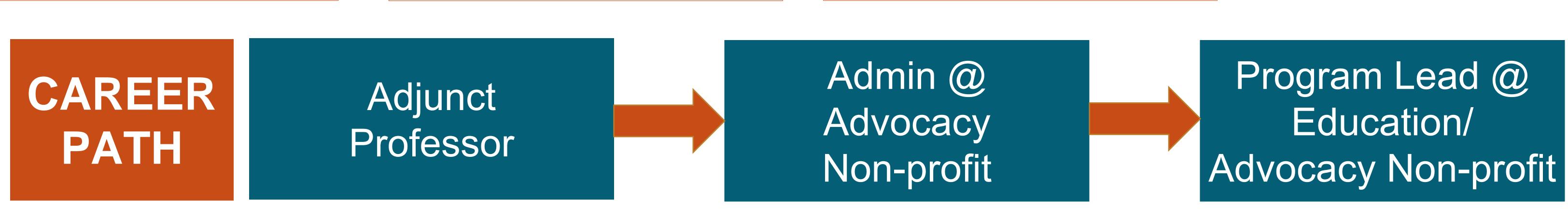
