What I do at work

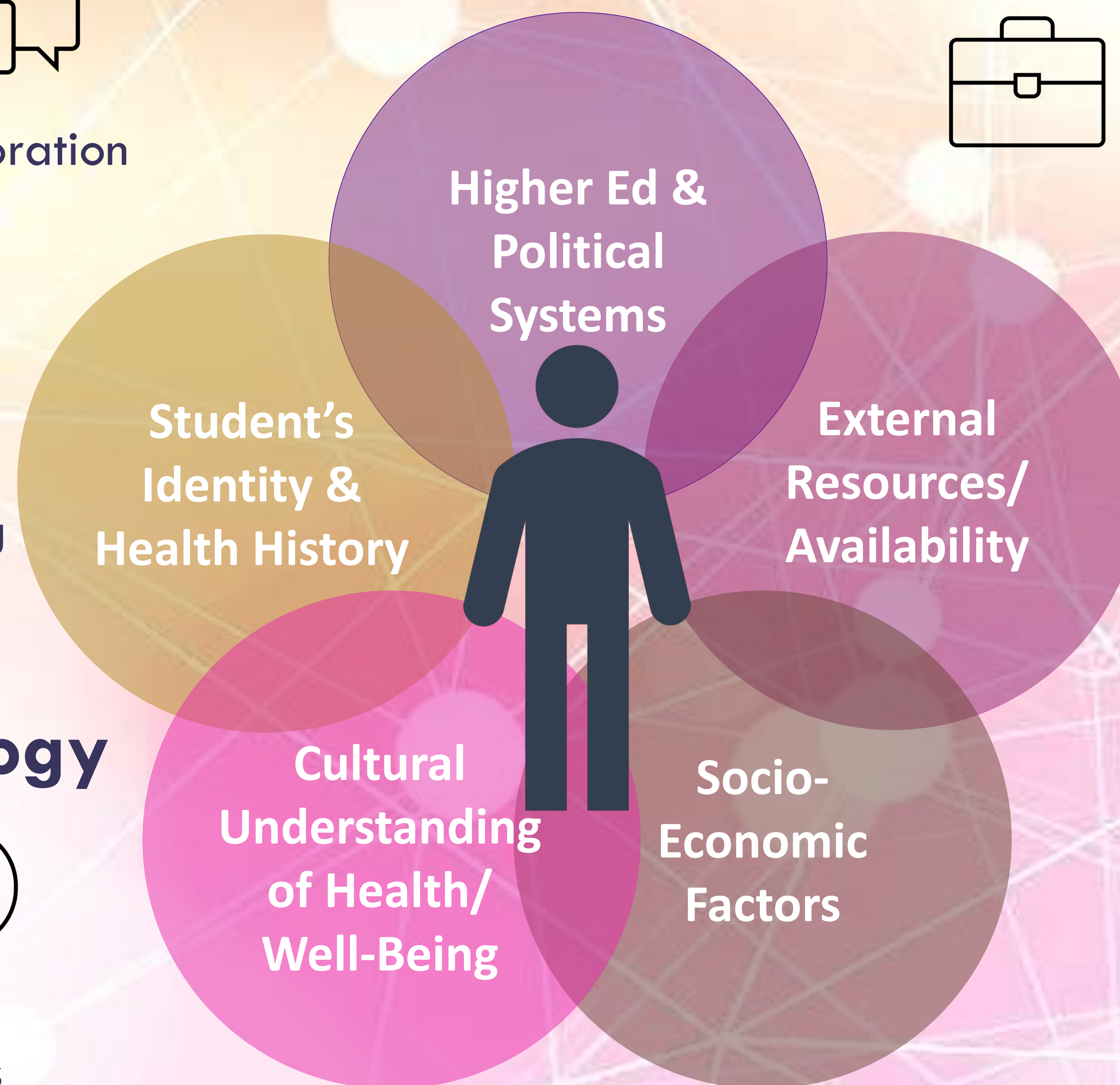


- Non-clinical risk assessment

- Data collection, analysis, & presentation

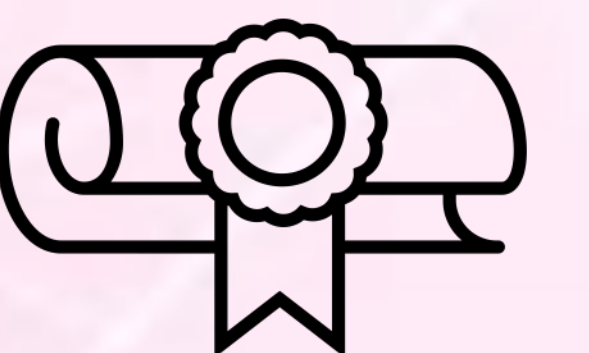
