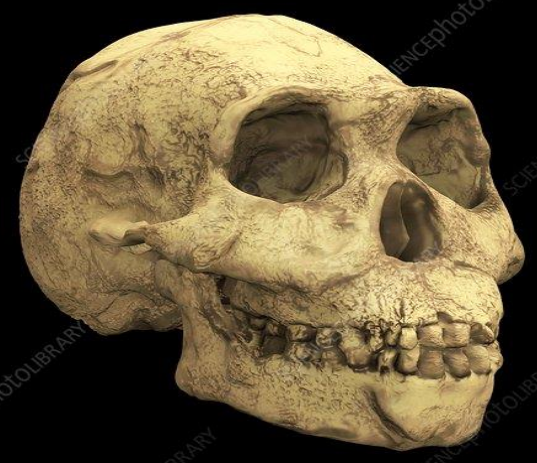


# Biological Anthropology Internship at the Museum
