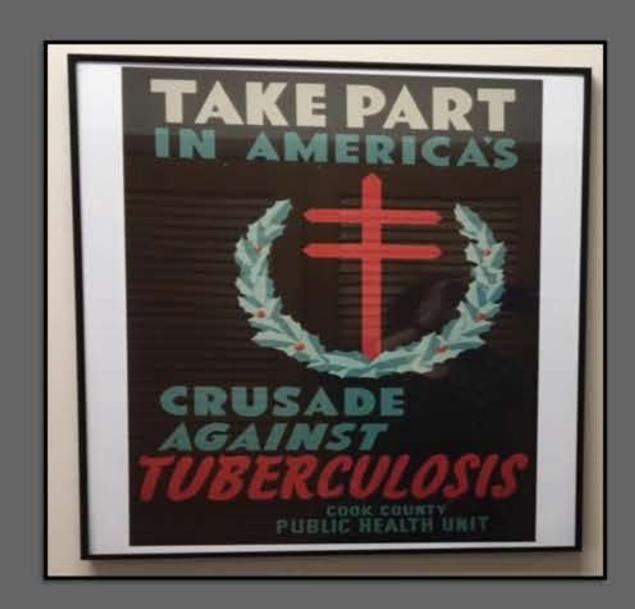

Anthropology & Public Health Focus On:

Human Systems Analysis

- · Focus on the community rather than individuals
- Create structural and/or process change
- Determine relationships between organizations
- Focus on/create benefits for multiple partners (health in all policies)
- Examine my part in the system (structural racism)

Participant Input

- Analyze systems from view of participant and stakeholders
- Focus on engagement not outreach

Cultural Variation

- Understanding there are cultural differences, in communication, timeline, relationship building, etc.
- Lifting voices that are often unheard
- Openness and listening: residents as experts
 - e.g. Eurocentric timelines, communication styles, relationship building methods
